**The isolation of Dungeness had proved an irresistible lure to smuggling gangs: the absence of prying eyes and wagging tongues meant that they could carry on their work undisturbed. In a single week of 1813 free-traders were known to have landed 12000 gallons of brandy here. Nor was this the first cargo of spirits to cross the coastline illegally at Dungeness: 180 years earlier the local smugglers lured aground the Spanish vessel, Alfresia. They murdered the crew and looted the cargo of spirits. The ship was used to build the original Pilot and some of the original timbers remain in the bar today.**
